

Australian Childcare Alliance Qld (ACA Qld) is pleased to announce the launch of:

Flying Squad

This is an exciting opportunity for retired teachers or those taking a career break.

As you may know, early childhood education and care (ECEC) services are experiencing severe staffing shortages, which means it's often difficult to release teachers-in-training to undertake their prac placements.

ACA Qld's 'Flying Squad' is a free new service to assist ECEC services to find suitably qualified, temporary staff. Priority is currently being given to covering absences on prac for people studying their Early Childhood Teaching (ECT) degree. Prac placements are typically between two and four weeks. A Flying Squad member replacing an ECT on prac will most likely work with kindergarten children, although not always.

Under the sector's regulations, you are qualified to undertake one of these temporary assignments if you have:

- an ECT degree,
- a Primary teaching degree or
- a Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care or equivalent.

ACA Qld's role is to match a service with interested and suitably qualified candidates. The employment arrangements are a matter between the service and the Flying Squad member.

There is no charge for this service.
